

## Wesleyan College Class of 2020 Undergraduate Career Outcomes

The Wesleyan College Center for Career Development calculates undergraduate career outcomes in accordance with guidelines laid out by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). We calculate and report our undergraduates' "positive career outcomes rates," which includes graduates who are employed full-time or part-time, pursuing entrepreneurial ventures, employed in internships/fellowships, pursuing a volunteer/service opportunity, serving in the military, enrolled in graduate school, or pursuing other types of continuing education. As per NACE guidelines, these percentages are calculated based on the total number of student responses, and do not include students who indicated "not seeking employment." However, we provide a full breakdown of the status of all graduates below.

Out of the 134 Wesleyan College and dual-degree Wesleyan College/Guangzhou University graduates, including December 2019, May 2020, and August 2020 graduates, we know the status of 127 of them. This gives us a knowledge rate of 95% for the class of 2020. (Note that for the outcomes rates on this web page, we include the outcomes of dual-degree Wesleyan College/Guangzhou University graduates.)

The knowledge rate of 95% exceeds the NACE suggested knowledge rate of 65%, and was obtained through both graduating student survey responses and staff research. This information was collected between December 15, 2019 and December 11, 2020. Data collection strategies included:

- Surveying students in person at events
- Surveying students via an online survey tool
- Surveying students via telephone and email after graduation
- Employing the assistance of faculty, staff and administrators to obtain and/or verify data
- Conducting online research on social media sites, LinkedIn, and organizational websites
