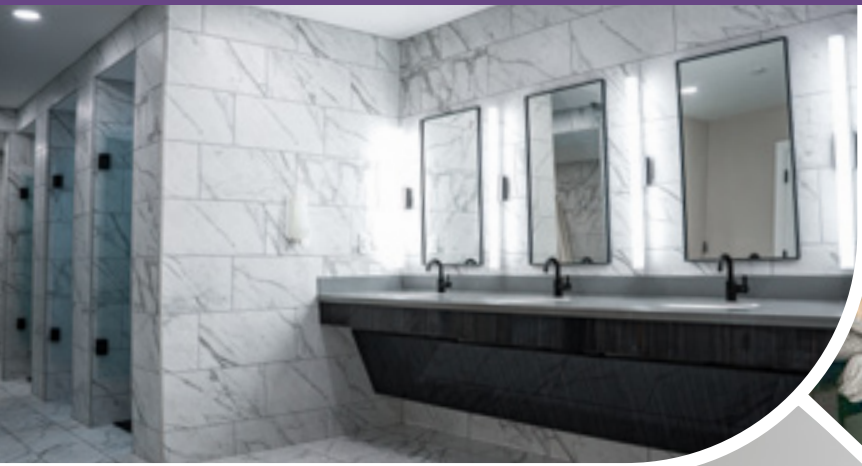


YOUR HOME BASE FOR WHAT'S NEXT

- **24/7 support from live-in Resident Assistants throughout all four years**

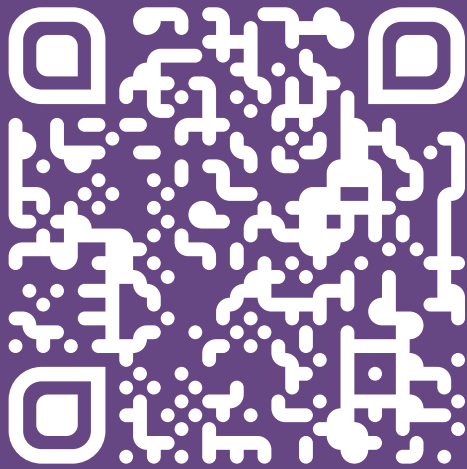


Macon

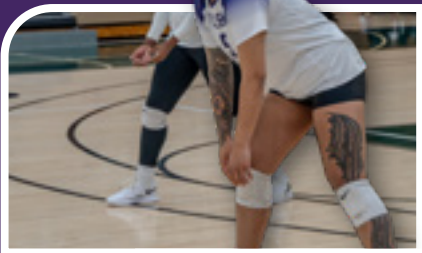
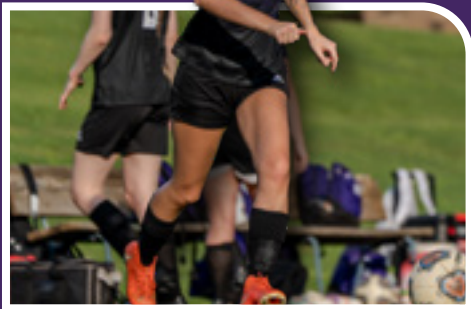
WELCOME TO THE WOLF PACK

WHEN AND HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1: Complete an application by visiting wesleyancollege.edu or through Common App.

There is no application fee, and applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. You will receive your admission and scholarship decision within days.

STEP 2: Submit your transcripts.

Apply by uploading your unofficial high-school transcripts. Your final official transcripts are not required until after graduation, before you enroll at Wesleyan. We are proudly test-optional, an SAT or ACT is not required to apply.

STEP 3: Apply for scholarships, and complete your FAFSA!

Apply for Wesleyan’s Premier Scholarships, and complete your FAFSA early. Together, these opportunities can significantly reduce your out-of-pocket costs, often making a Wesleyan education comparable to or even less expensive than many public colleges.

STEP 4: Secure your spot!

You’re in! Once admitted, submit your non-refundable \$300 deposit and begin preparing for First-Year Orientation. We’ll provide a personalized checklist to guide you through enrollment, class registration, and connecting with your future classmates. This is where the fun begins! Welcome home!
